SCF has been instilled with this true spirit of service for the last 24 years, since its inception in 1991. This spirit of selfless service has been relentlessly recognized and upheld by GHMC (Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation) authorities, Govt. of Telangana, Schools & Colleges, Top Administration Officials, Experienced coaches, True philanthropists and Media, who continue to support this passion of SCF in tirelessly serving India through the Sports medium.

It is important to note that such continued support and success over two decades could not have been possible without the selfless intention of service of Mr. K. Sai Baba.

SCF provides coaching facilities in the following disciplines – Cricket, Football, Tennis, Volleyball, Basketball, Kho Kho, Kabaddi, Aerobics, Kick Boxing and General Fitness. A clear majority of the trainees at SCF, who want to pursue sports seriously, are from under-privileged background. **SCF provides free coaching to 60% of its trainees, in accordance with its policy. This underlines the service spirit of SCF to the nation.** Specially note that **SCF is a Non-Profit and Non-Commercial Organization**. One of the outstanding achievements at the time of its inception in 1991 was the colossal effort put into transforming a sensitive area of Masab Tank, which was essentially a marshy dumping yard, into an enviable, state-of-the-art miniature sports infrastructure (now SCF) with Flood Lights facilities (since 1993, Courtesy Andhra Pradesh State Electricity Board) SCF was the first-of-its kind miniature sports facility in India. This goal was successfully accomplished, in coordination with efforts from GHMC. **Our Flood Lights have been witness to thousands of sporting events conducted over the last 24 years!**

SCF continues to provide most modern infrastructure for Trainees and National/International sportsmen through its state-of-the-art special facilities. Over its 24 year span, SCF has successfully instilled human

values with the spirit of sporting excellence to enable young children groom into responsible citizens of India. **Recently, SCF launched an ingenious project 'Build India through Sports', which aspires to spread awareness about Sports in Government Schools and also support infrastructure for continued sports activity. As part of this effort, SCF has already reached out to more than 50 Government schools,** where some students have had no exposure to sports of any kind. SCF has donated sporting equipment and created basic infrastructure in these schools to promote sports like Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Kho Kho and Kabaddi Track & field.

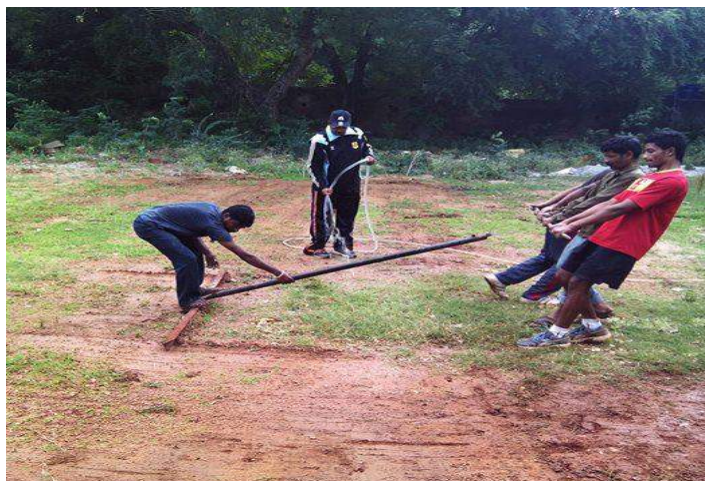

Several Thousands of street children every year have benefitted from the modern sports facilities & encouragement provided by SCF. The importance of all round personality development is etched into their character and life. **This has all been made possible for the last 24 years by the time & money invested and unparalleled efforts of Mr. K. Saibaba, the backbone and breath of SCF.**

LIMITS are for those who don't stand up to do something and achieve unimaginable in their lives. Achievements are not the pebbles one can see but the ones that we feel. Saibaba is one among such people who has walked the tough terrains. A person who represented his state in Ranji trophy, played and rubbed shoulder with giants of the game a respectable job in one of the nationalized banks, he has everything in his life.

But dissatisfaction accrued in his heart. He started exploring the reason and finally landed in the ground with just one idea, an idea that changed his life. The idea was to set up a non-profit voluntary organization for sports coaching or children hailing from all classes of the social and financial strata without expecting any profit.

Exuberant fascination

The love towards the game made him walk into the ground. He represented in Ranji trophy between 1978 and 1982. He has also represented Andhra Pradesh state team in canoeing (water sports). He was elected managing committee member in Hyderabad Cricket Association during 1986-87. That year was the golden period for HCA, winning all the age group level inter state tournaments. Hyderabad cricket team was national Ranji trophy champion during this period.

After working for many years in a bank, Sai foundation in the city. The government extended its helping hand by offering him adequate place to set up a quality academy

Not just a coach

Sai baba did not restrict to just train the young talent. He through his foundation also organizes many tournaments to tap the talent. Saibaba also acquired 80 Gincom tax Exemption for his non-profit organization in 1991 sports coaching foundation also has membership with symbiotic benefits. Different government and corporate organizations recognized Sai baba's Services to the children and started donating funds to uplift the sporting culture in the society.

Govt shortlists 10 key areas of CSR

New Delhi: The government has identified 10 major areas including education, gender equality, environment, national heritage and the Prime minister Relief fund where India Inc can spend to claim credit for the mandatory 2% Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) expenditure.

Under the new Companies Act, mid and large companies have to spend 2% of their three year annual average net profit on CSR activities. The government expects a significant step up in spending on CSR projects by companies.

The activities which can be included by companies in their CSR policies include: eradicating hunger, poverty, malnutrition and promoting preventive healthcare, promoting sanitation and availability of safe drinking water, promoting education, promoting gender equality, ensuring environmental sustainability, protection of national heritage.

Those spending for the benefit of armed forces veterans, war widows and their dependents would be eligible to cover the expenses under CSR spending rules. Under gender equality activities related to empowering women, setting

up homes and hostels for women and orphans, setting up old age homes, day care centres and similar facilities for senior citizens

and projects on reducing inequalities faced by socially and economically backward groups have been included.

Spending on training to promote rural and nationally recognised para olympic and Olympic sports would also qualify for credit under the CSR rules.

Rural development projects and contributions or funds to technology incubators located within academic institutions and approved by the government would also be approved under this category. Protection of national heritage would include art and culture including restoration of building and sites of historical importance and works of art, setting up of public libraries, promotion and development of traditional arts and handicrafts.

Officials said they expect the rules to be notified soon, maybe within a few days, after the Law ministry approves the list. The rules were finalised after the Corporate Affairs ministry examined over one lakh suggestions from various stakeholders. While the rules do not elaborate on the sub categories under rural development projects, officials said they expect several projects to be covered under the category for CSR spending.
