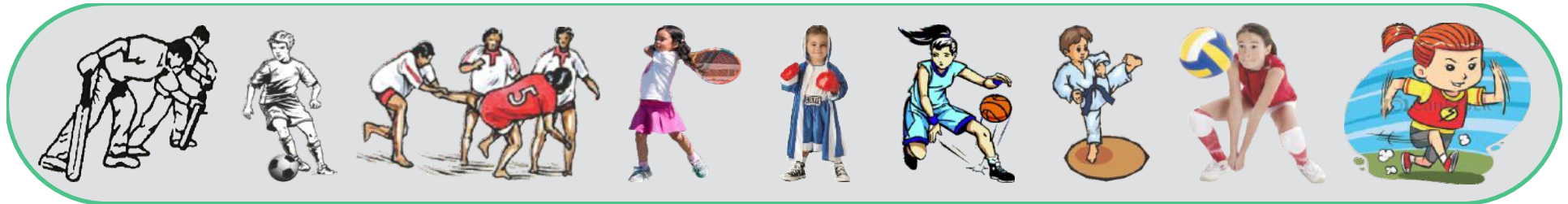

### *Message from the SCF Founder...*

#### ***Sincere Greetings from K. Saibaba!***

*Please allow me to introduce our Sports NGO – Sports Coaching Foundation, Hyderabad! Following is a very short and interesting description of our Foundation. Hope you will appreciate it.*

***Sports Coaching Foundation (SCF)*** started its first venture at SCF Sports Complex in about an acre area of land at Masab Tank, Hyderabad in Private Public Partnership (PPP) with Government. Please note that the area surrounding SCF Sports Complex is until today - one of the most sensitive areas in Hyderabad Police records. Simply put, this sensitive area has anti-social elements, land grabbers, vagabonds, drug peddlers and street urchins. I must admit that in its initial stage, SCF was pelted with stones for being proactive and innovative in promoting Sporting Culture even among underprivileged children. This had a lot to do with the misconception that SCF had an ulterior commercial intention. Later, with time, these very people (who pelted us) realized the true and sincere motive of SCF in promoting Sports Culture among the underprivileged for their own betterment in three areas of life – Health, Fitness and Character. Now, their very own children take coaching at our SCF Sports Complex. The realization has taken time, but has finally come. **Please note that more than 90% of 600 SCF Trainees (mostly underprivileged) undergo Free Scientific Coaching at SCF Sports Complex.** Only 10% of SCF Trainees pay fees (donation) to the Foundation, which is again recycled back into promoting Sports Promotion among the underprivileged.

***Please note that we were the first role model Sports organization in India on several fronts.*** In its Initial stages, we approached philanthropists and like-minded organizations for funding. We directly invested funds into our Floodlight Project for our SCF Sports Complex, Electronic Bowling Machine & Synthetic Astro-Turf wickets. We were the first in India (in 1994) to acquire all the above equipment and develop Sports infrastructure. Later, we also acquired the Digital Speed Gun. Note that at SCF Complex, we also have an Extensive library, Audio-Visual Room and LCD Projector to practically educate sportspersons. Thus, we were able to develop the SCF Sports Complex (a mini-stadium) with the most modern Sports Infrastructure. This attracted both, the underprivileged and the elite to our SCF Sports Complex at Masab Tank, Hyderabad. Time has proved the success of SCF model of operation.

***Please note that all our Sports Promotion activities fall under our 'Build India Through Sports (BITS)' Project.*** Barring heavy social odds, SCF promoted Sports in several Sporting Disciplines (Football, Tennis, Basketball, Cricket, Kabaddi, Boxing & Martial Arts) at its Sports Complex and developed it in a phase wise manner over the last 25 years, especially for underprivileged children and youth of Slum areas. **Please note that in a very unique way, SCF provides a unique platform for underprivileged and privileged children to interact through Sporting activities.** Weekly, Privileged Children also distribute gifts to the underprivileged. At a very early age, children at SCF learn the habit of giving and sharing...

*SCF distributes its refined Coaching Manuals in different Sporting disciplines, which teach children & youth beyond Sports. Apart from technical skills, these manuals strongly emphasize on the importance of something as simple as Smiling for Good Health, about Human Values & Building Character. Please note that our Coach to Trainee ratio is 1: 20, which means that personalized attention is giving to each Trainee. Thousands of children and youth have taken advantage of this SCF system of Sports and Character Development. Few SCF Trainees have even represented India. Annually, SCF also conducts 30 Free Tournaments, Events & Seminars round the year. Many children having Criminal Background have also been transformed through our Model of Coaching and Character Development.*

*Next, we thought that instead of just being restricted to promoting Sports Culture among children and youth at SCF Sports Complex, we need to spread the message over a large scale in the society that 'Education without Sports is incomplete'. This intention gave birth to the idea of 'Mobile BITS Project'. Through our limited finances and funds raised, SCF started visiting the doorsteps of Low-income institutions (Govt. Schools, Municipal Schools, Orphanage Homes, Street-children Homes, also Abandoned Street-corners and Gated Communities) and promoting Sports Culture. This experiment clicked. So far, through its 'Mobile BITS Project', SCF has reached out to over 30,000 underprivileged children and youth in over 100 Low-income Institutions in states of Telangana State, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Goa and in cities like Pune, Mumbai and Delhi. Through this Project, SCF developed Sports Infrastructure from grass-root level (where required at Low-income Institutions), conducted Sports Clinics (we realized that Large stadiums are not really required to engage children into Sports and sporting lectures) and finally donated Sporting Equipment required at these Low-income institutions.*

*We spread the message that 'Sports is the Cheapest Medicine for Good Health'. Please note that SCF mission is to replicate and scale the activities of 'Mobile BITS Project' all over India. We aim to reach out to every nook and corner in the country and spread the message that Sports can truly empower and transform the lives of the underprivileged masses. For this, we need like-minded partners and donors who share a common vision of 'Overall Personality Development of Children & Youth through Sports'.*

*We are not asking any entity for direct donation, not at all. In fact, we want you to correspond with us (we recommend you to even visit our Beautiful Sports Complex at Masab Tank, Hyderabad) regarding our mission, see the selfless work that we are doing through our BITS Project, the progress we have made so far and the passion with which we are promoting Sports Culture among thousands of underprivileged children to decide whether you need to lend a helping hand. Only, after you are satisfied with the progress we have made, you can decide whether you need to partner with us. However, please open your mind to the work that we are pursuing at the grass-root level of the society for more than 2 decades and recommend better ways of empowering the underprivileged masses through Sports.*

# Great honour to an exemplary cricketer

*International Association of Lions Club confers Fellow of Excellence award on Sai Baba for promoting sports amongst the under-privileged*

It was pleasant surprise for K. Saibaba, a former Ranji player and founder secretary of the Sports Coaching Foundation (Masab Tank) who was presented with the Life Award by the International Association of Lions club (District 324 C2) at an impressive function in the city last week.



District Convener 'Lion' Sunil Kumar said that the award – Fellow of Excellence – was conferred on Saibaba for his selfless service in promoting sports amongst the underprivileged by continuously taking up innumerable schemes with plenty of incentives to ensure that enthusiastic kids sustain their interest in sports. For someone who is running the foundation, which is an acknowledged NGO run in coordination with greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation, for the last 16 years, Saibaba ensured that it remained one of the best well – maintained training centers with latest facilities including a bowling machine, floodlights and synthetic wickets, he commented.

"This actually reflects the recognition of Saibaba's commitment and the sacrifices he made our years to keep in place a truly model training centre," he said. "It also reminds our passion to be associated with truly distinguished personalities and our gratitude and admiration for the quality of contribution that has been consistently rendered by him over the years," the citation observed.

Responding to the felicitation, Sai Baba felt he was humbled by the "huge and rare honor". "This should only spur me to continue all the good work we have been doing at the foundation," he remarked. "A visit to the Foundation would portray the actual picture of all the good work done by us for the under-privileged inspired this award, we will only try to improve upon our outlook to the whole concept," he concluded.

# SCF gets Rockefeller honour

The city-based multipurpose Sports Coaching Foundation (SCF) has won a rare recognition for an NGO that is dedicated exclusively to sports. It is one among four to be conferred the coveted 'India NGO Award' for the year. It is the only sports NGO in the latest roll of honours.

"What makes this a very special one is that it has been instituted jointly by the New York-based Rockefeller Foundation, the London-based Resource Alliance and the Mum-

bai-headquartered EdelGive Foundation," said a beaming K Sai Baba, the Foundation's founder-Secretary late Friday evening.

Stating that this would mark a major milestone in their history, he said that the recognition would instill a new zeal among all those associated with the Foundation whereby they would aim to further their spread and ensure that they reach as many youngsters as possible in the days ahead.

SCF which completes its silver jubilee next year, has been in the forefront of promoting



the prevalence of a sports culture, particularly among youngsters belonging to the economically backward sections of the society. "Although, we have been able to groom a good number of talents, the satisfaction was

more pronounced when three of our products, woman cricketer Archana Das and footballers Simar Preet Singh and Mohd Tariq were picked for the national teams," pointed out Sai Baba, a former Ranji cricketer himself.

According to Sudden Deshmukh, the Foundation Administrator, the focus was on taking the Build India Through Sports (BITS) to newer regions. Having accomplished substantial results in the two Telugu speaking States apart from Maharashtra and Karnataka,

they hope to enter other States. New Delhi, where a BITS pilot run received impressive response when the team received the award, has been quite encouraging, he quipped.

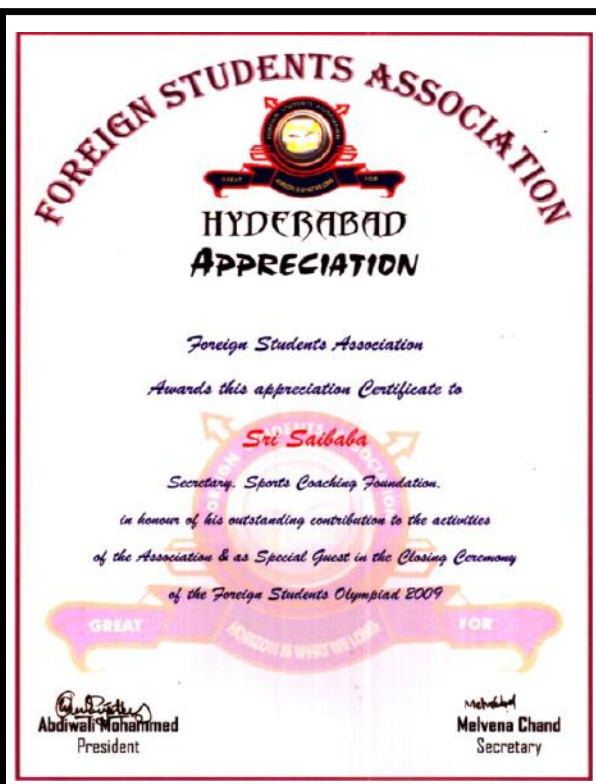

## Mohammed Habib - Pride of Hyderabad

1. Mohammed Habib is a Double Olympian, who represented National Football Team from 1965-1975 and also had his tenure as Indian captain. For his inspiring contribution to Football in India, Mohd. Habib received the very prestigious 'Arjuna Award' in 1980 and 'Bharat Gaurav Award' in 2015. Mohd. Habib's fighting spirit, concentration and passion for the game made him possibly the most important player for his club sides and the national team. He played as a Forward and scored decisive goals in Tournament Finals.
2. Note that from 1970 to 1974, Mohd. Habib played a very important role in fortunes of the East Bengal team. In 1972, Mohd. Habib was in unstoppable form in the Durand Cup as he scored a record winning 12 goals in 7 matches. Along with five league titles for East Bengal, Mohd. Habib won the Durand Cup twice, Rovers Cup twice and IFA Shield four times.
3. Having rejoined Mohun Bagan in 1976, Mohd. Habib lend incredibility stability to the Mohun Bagan Team. In 1977, Mohun Bagan scored a massive 82 goals in 27 matches in IFA League, a record till date. Habib continued his trophy winning streak in Mohun Bagan winning IFA League twice, IFA Shield thrice, Durand Cup once and Rovers Cup twice..
4. In 1968, Mohd. Habib was badly injured in the Santosh Trophy semi-final against Punjab. He was rushed to the hospital and given saline. Still insisting to play in the replay match, Mohd. Habib managed to score 5 goals in the final of Santosh Trophy, a record, as Bengal trounced Services 5-1.
5. Since his retirement in 1984, Mohd. Habib has remained a part of Football. His greatest feat has been with Tata Football Academy where he oversaw their rise as the prime academy in India. He remains a role model for anyone pursuing Football.

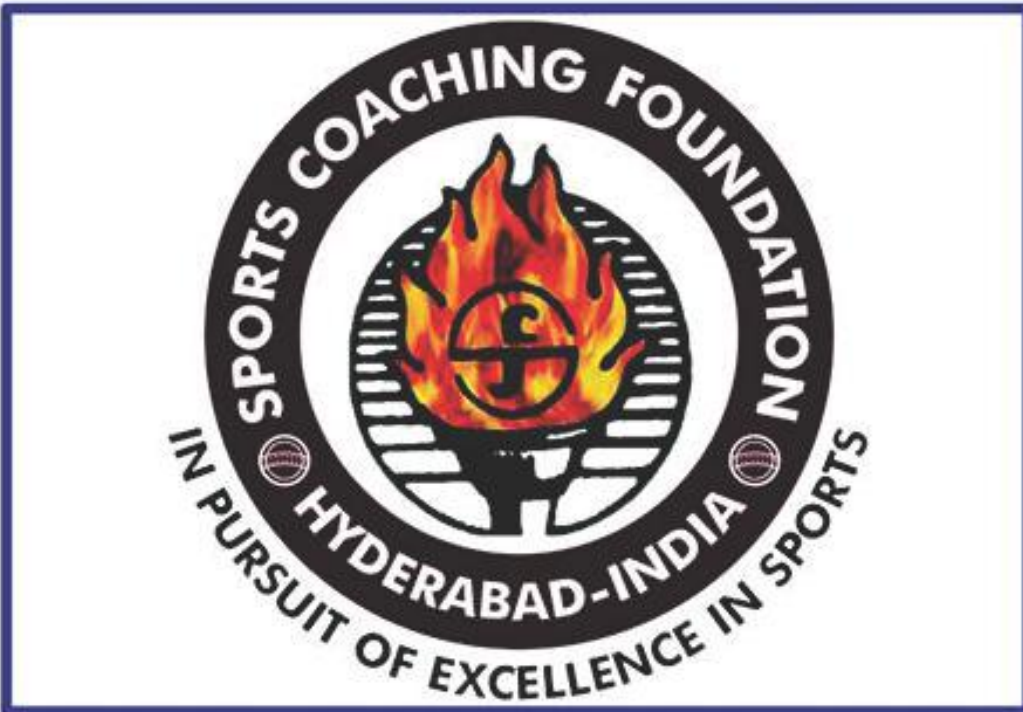
