The primary focus is on personality development through the Sports medium.

In altruistic, sporting sprit

Sports Coaching Foundation is reaching out to promote sporting activity in Government schools

Sports Coaching Foundation (at Masab Tank, Hyderabad) has embarked on an innovative project 'Build India Through Sports' which aims at not only spreading awareness about sports in select Government Schools but also ensure that a sports-friendly ambience is created on the premises with the hope of a continuity for sports activity.

"We initially hold discussions with the School management involving the Physical Education Teacher which is almost like a seminar and try to explain the importance of having sporting activity on their premises which should also result in better academic results. Recreation should be part of any curriculum," feels K. Sai Baba, general secretary of the SCF which has already reached out to 50 such schools where some of the students who have never seen any sports equipment of quality are already getting a feel of what it is.

the exclusive girls schools to provide the right dose of inspiration. "Yes, it is a fact that some of them don't even have a level playing field, leave alone play facilities. That is exactly why we are trying to reach out by installing make-shift basketball rings, levelling whatever play area is available. We have provided

facilitate personality development and develop human values, with the help of the success stories of champions like Sania Mirza, Saina Nehwal are explained to the children. Also, school students have a platform by way of free-entry to events which the SCF conducts to showcase their skills and dream big.

The second step, depending on the response of the schools, involves a visit by the coaching faculty armed with the basic sports equipment to give some sort of demo out on the sports arenas to lure students into sporting activity. "Mind you, this is not a commercial venture but purely funded by the NGO which is a non-profit organisation supported by crucial wings of the State government including the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation since 1991," reminds Sai, a former Andhra Ranji cricketer and also Executive Committee member of the Hyderabad Cricket Association.

The project involves educating the children about the stupendous sporting achievements like five-time World women's boxing champion Mary Kom, especially among

dozens of footballs and basketballs to many schools already to see that there is some activity," explains the SCF general secretary.

What is the reason for this project to take off? "From my own experience, it is the Government schools which lack the desired impetus and support. So, I thought let us start from there to cater to the lower strata of the society," he replies.

The whole project is being pursued with sheer passion within the SCF's limited financial resources and without any corpus fund for the same, he insists, adding, "We will be more than happy if there is sporting activity throughout the year; the SCF is always there to help any school in this regard."

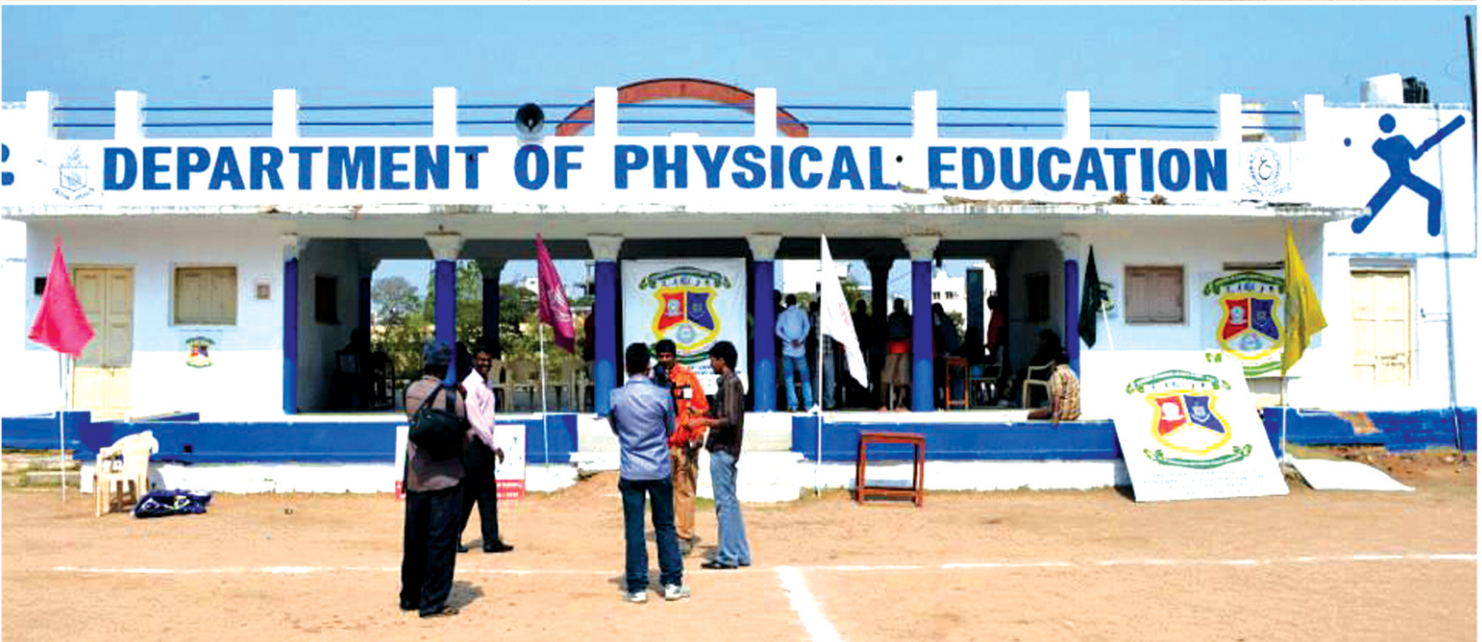
In a way it is a concept which uses sports as a tool to

Sai Baba points out that the response was really good in some schools like Sabdaria Girls High School (Mehdipatnam) which has 1200 students and the Errum Manzil Government High School. "It gives us immense pleasure that now many Government Schools are making use of the equipment we donated and also the basic infrastructure like creating volleyball, basketball, kho kho and kabaddi courts too," he says.

Interestingly, many of the Government School students too get a feel of the bowling machine of the SCF, incidentally the first organization in India to get this way back in early 90s, digital speed gun. "We hope to contribute in our own small way for the promotion of sports. This is an ongoing project," signs off the SCF official.

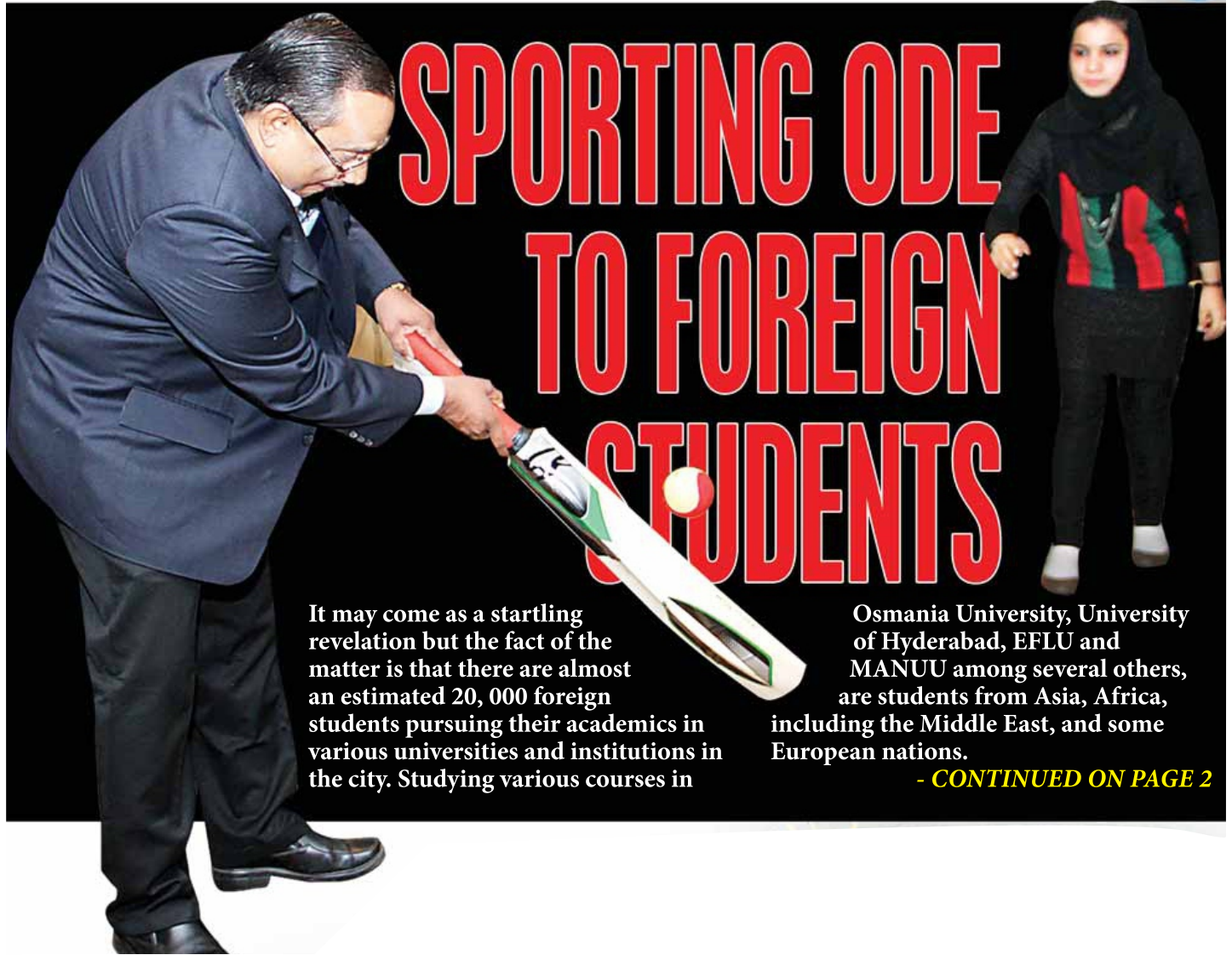

HYDERABAD: For the 15,000-odd foreign students based in Hyderabad, more so from Osmania University and Nizam College, it was a unique opportunity to showcase their skills at the Sports Coaching Foundation (Masab Tank) three-day sports meet, which got under way at Nizam College Grounds here on Thursday.

"Well, we don't want to think of what is happening back home right now. We are enjoying every bit of this sports meet," said Zahid Hasan, coach of the 1,000-strong Iraqi student community in the city, with a smile.

He observed that these are the kind of events which provide students a chance to meet other foreign nationals. The fact that girl students, mostly from Af-

ghanistan, made their presence felt in the event, was also a hint of how desperately these overseas students are looking for a platform to try their hand at sprint events in athletics, basketball, football and cricket.

With V. Satyanarayana, Director of Physical Education, OU, and S. Rajesh Kumar, professor, taking care of the technical aspects of the three-day meet, the participants can be assured of a smooth conduct of events.

"Our idea is to lure overseas students outdoors as they are usually confined to the indoors. We are hoping our own local students will get inspired watching foreign students participate in the sporting events," said K. Sai Baba of Sports Coaching Foundation (SCF), who is organising the event.

The Nizam College at Basheerbagh turned into a global playground as students from 35 countries participated in a first-of-its-kind sports event in the city on Thursday. Some of the countries may be at war with other countries, but on the ground, it was friendly camaraderie that was on display, as 500 students pursuing various courses, participated in different events.

Making the three-day event unique was the kick-off, where the participants unfurled the flags of their respective countries. The first day was dedicated to athletics and football. "Tomorrow, it will be a field day of basketball, volleyball, football and cricket. The third and concluding day will see games of football, volleyball, karate and cricket," informed an organiser at the venue.

Students from Yemen, Iraq, Iran, Turkey, Uzbekistan, Sudan, South Sudan, Congo, Tanzania, Somalia, Uganda, Congo and other countries from Asia and Africa studying

gathered for games.

The cricket matches promise to be different as the teams will be mixed with both boys and girls playing in the same team. Each team will comprise five girls and five boys and without the eleventh player. The shorter duration matches will be of 10 overs each. There will be five teams for football, nine teams for basketball, five teams for volleyball and six teams for basketball. Saeed Anwar, a karate champion in his early twenties from Afghanistan, appeared excited as he displayed his skill in the inaugural session, breaking several clay pots with swift chops. "I am going to be the winner," he says with confidence.

Mohammed Nasir Ahmed from Afghanistan, an MBA student of Osmania University, who is also the president of Foreign Students Association Hyderabad, sums it up, "Students are calling up for registration even now. This has brought students from different countries on one platform."

Make sports a way of life, says Minister

GUWAHATI: Union Minister of State for Youth Affairs and Sports (Independent) Sarbananda Sonowal on Saturday appealed to State governments to identify sites in every block for creating sports infrastructure to help realise the goal set by the Centre to make sports "a way of life."

During an interaction with journalists here, the Minister said that his ministry had set the goal of building sports complexes in each of the more than 7,000 development blocks of the country under the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Abhiyan programme and would require cooperation of the State Governments as

sports is a State subject.

The objective is to harness the sports talent in rural areas and make India a sporting hub of the world, he said.

Mr. Sonowal announced that his ministry would organise the first edition of the Himalayan Region Sports meet with participation of north-eastern States, Jammu and Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Bhutan and Nepal, in Guwahati.

He said the Indian Olympic Association had conveyed its decision to make Guwahati as the venue of South Asian Federation Games.

The Minister said that the National Youth Festival would be held in Guwahati from January 8 to 12.

Concept of ODIs was alien to us: Syed Abid Ali

Former India all-rounder Syed Abid Ali recalls the inaugural World Cup of 1975

With the 2015 World Cup set to roll in a couple of days, the sight of Syed Abid Ali, the former India all-rounder, walking into the Sports Coaching Foundation (Masab Tank) almost unnoticed presents the other side of India's history in the biggest cricketing spectacle. Not all World Cuppers are fortunate to

earn name and fame. For, not many know that Abid Ali, now 73 and more popularly known in Hyderabad cricketing circles as 'Chichha', was one of the couple of Indian players who can recall their experience of playing in the inaugural World Cup in 1975 in England with a sense of pride. One of his memorable outings was against New Zealand when he scored 70 and then claimed two for 35. The only other Indian to score a half-century was the great

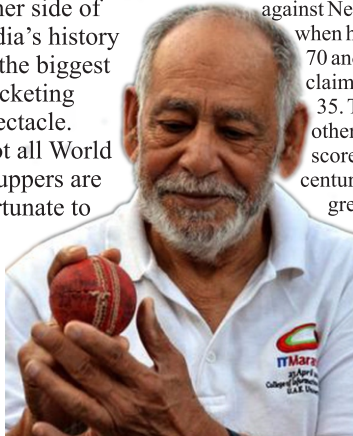


Former cricketer Syed Abid Ali with children at a coaching camp. Photo: V.V. Subrahmanyam

were the days when India was not really ready for the limited-overs brand. But, the fun of being part of that World Cup is something unforgettable, he says. Not many of the current generation may be aware that Abid Ali had a dream Test debut at Brisbane in 1967-68 series with six for 55 against Australia. So, he should know what he speaks about the World Cup and all. The Hyderabad reveals that India did not show the team spirit desired at that level in 1975. "The team was perplexed and the concept of ODIs

itself was alien to us," he adds. One of the most infamous episodes of 1975 World Cup episode was Sunil Gavaskar's mind-boggling 36 not out in 60 overs against England. "I still cannot believe how it happened. And I had the gumption to ask Sunny what happened - his reply was that he was not a stroke-maker. To this my reply was - don't tell me that you got all those Test runs prior to World Cup without playing any strokes," recalls Abid Ali. On his World Cup experience, Abid Ali says that being at Lord's

to watch West Indian captain's blazing and match-winning century, Sir Vivian Richards amazing run-outs in the 1975 final, Kapil Dev's incredible catch to send back Viv Richards off Madan Lal in the 1983 final were some of the great memories he would love to keep recalling even now. "What moments they were. Truly special which were equal to the grand finales," he says. ater, SCF general secretary K. Sai Baba introduced Abid Ali to the young cricketers who were too happy to have an interaction with him.
