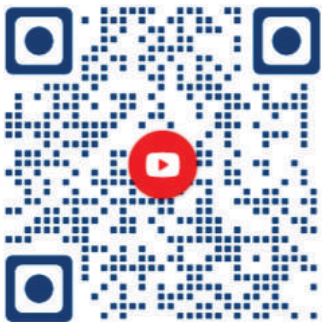

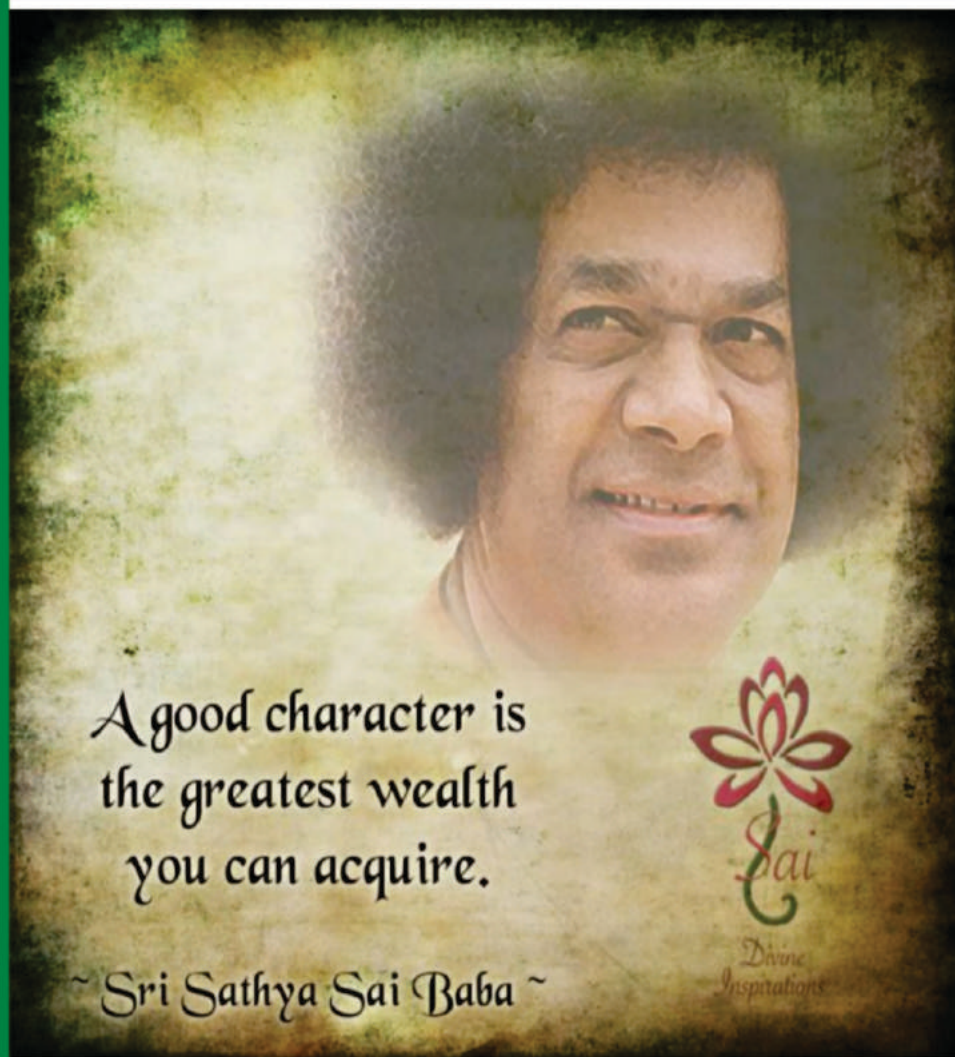

**A home coming for the Indian off-spinner**

*Coming back from her recent trip to West Indies and playing against the Aussies in the T-20 series in Vizag 23-year-old Archana still has her feet on the ground*

**I**t was some coming for the India and Archana Das. Usually, when she visits the Sports Coaching Foundation, an 80-year-old woman, P. S. S. Das, is the one who greets her. It was at the time of her last visit in 2010 and she got the special support from people like S. N. Babu, general secretary of SCF, former IFC's managing secretary T. S. Pillay and Stella Raju, SCF's secretary at Hyderabad Grounds.

Playing against the Aussies in the T-20 series in Vizag, the 23-year-old Archana, to the delight of her "mentors", will see her feet on the ground. Not many may be aware that it was at this ground she spent most of her childhood - usually, their mothers also would make a mark at the higher grade of women's cricket.

"Think, I remember the first time I got my feet on the ground for the first time. I would play for India one day," she admits anytime when the young women are talking about their childhood. "I got great with them for they helped me dream big and work really hard," recalls the India off-spinner whose spell of three hours in the field was the only T-20 game against the Aussies in the first match series in Vizag last week.

"I was with the girls when her father struggled to raise money because his business of making juke boxes and repairing the leading details in the construction was not really worth it at that time. There is a huge task definitely there for all of us. But, I was determined to see that my daughter did not lose her interest in cricket," says P. S. Das, who studied her from her father in the city in

1970s, but better prepared for her son and his daughter in cricket.

Sir P. S. Das who founded over a table tennis of the Hyderabad SCF to Archana, feels that it is character like the girl Archana who for the game gods. "These days there was no money at all in women's cricket. Even for officials to organize a tournament, it was an uphill task. Yet, that we could give these players the Archana was a tribute to their mother's spirit and to her mother's support," he emphasizes.

"I still dream big - to be a highly successful cricketer over a period of time. But, I cannot forget those good old days of this series when there were so many boys who helped me learn regularly. The coaching machine which was always ready for me was a big advantage," says Archana.

New South in Kolkata, Archana is in the mood to keep going well and play a key role in India's fortunes in the forthcoming T-20 series.

In a way, though Archana is a Kolkata girl, she feels that she was a birthright of SCF. It is the responsibility of India, to remember the girls who studied her from her father in the city in

Hyderabad, and K. Sai Baba, Sports Coaching Foundation general secretary, gave the prizes.

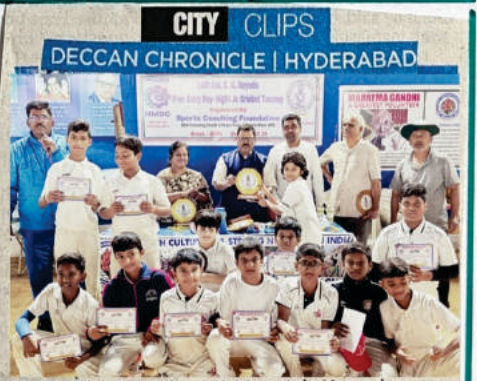

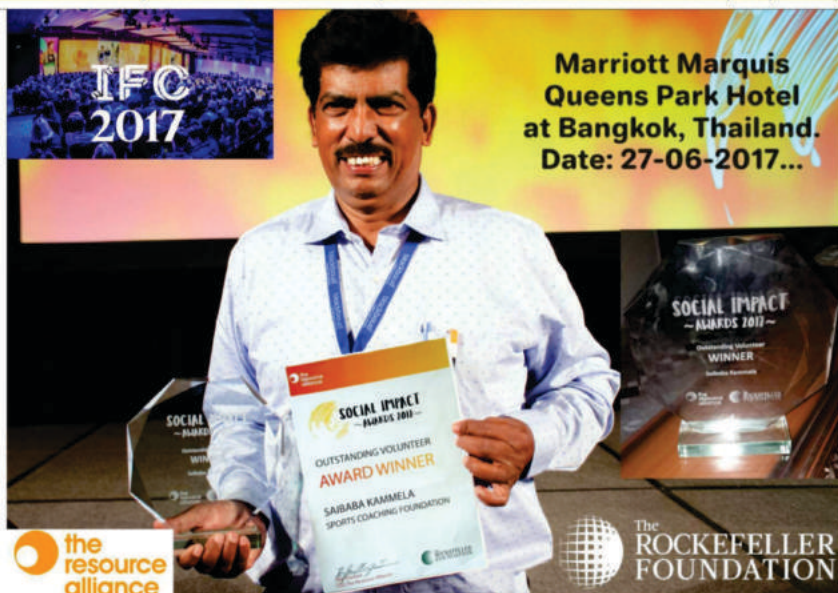
