# Celebrating a great achievement

**C**ity-based multipurpose NGO, Sports Coaching Foundation (SCF) was recently ranked among the top three organisations of its kind in the world by 'Peace and Sport Committee', Monaco as part of its 'Ninth International Forum'.

Celebrating this feat, a meet was held in the city in which former Director General of Police HJ Dora, along with SCF's head K Saibaba, was present.

Appreciating the efforts of SCF, Dora said, "For the past 25 years, Saibaba and SCF helped thousands of under privileged children to take up sports and games."

Sports Coaching Foundation located in Masab Tank began in 1991 with three children and it has now extended its family to 600 sports enthusiast kids who are trained there. The international recognition is another feather in its award-laden cap that comes for its 'Build India Through Sports (BITS) Project', which touched the lives of over 35,000 underprivileged children and youth all over India.

Stating that this would mark a major milestone in their history,

**HYDERABAD:** It was a dream come true for K. Sai Baba when he saw Olympic champions, including Yelena Isinbayeva, on the dais in Monaco!

What made it even more special was Mr. Baba's city-based Sports Coaching Foundation being named one of the top three NGOs in the world by the Peace and Sports Forum in Monaco for promoting development and peace through sport.

For the record, the other two in the top three list are Right to Movement based in Palestine and Afghan Connection based in the United Kingdom.

Back in the city after being invited to the award ceremony in Monaco, Mr. Baba said that more than the award itself, it was the

then AP Olympic Association H.J. Dora.

Incidentally, the award by Peace and Sports Forum was the first international recognition that the SCF has received, that too in the presence of distinguished guests, which included Olympic medallists, Prince Albert II of Monaco, Al Khalifa of Bahrain (heir to King of Bahrain and

president of Bahrain Olympic Committee), and Nobel prize winners.

"I was pleased to hear the message from United Nations Secretary-General's Special Adviser on Sport for Development and Peace Wilfried Lemke, who said Peace and Sports Forum was the best international forum for promoting development and peace through sports. This is exactly what the SCF has been doing in Masab Tank," he said.

Mr. Dora, who was instrumental in creating world-class infrastructure in the city like floodlighting the LB Stadium in 1991, bringing astro-turf to Begumpet Hockey Ground, and constructing the first-ever Olympic Bhavan in the country at LB Stadium, lauded the services of Mr. Baba.

## City's sports coaching body tops

Hyderabad-based Sports Coaching Foundation has been nominated among the top three sports NGOs in the world at the Peace and Sport Forum's 9th international summit in Monte Carlo, Monaco. An elated SCF founder and president K. Saibaba received the nomination at the conference.

This is the first international recognition for SCF, which had won the prestigious Rashtriya Khel Protsahan Puraskar at the Government of India sports awards last year besides five other national level awards.

Denmark's Right to Movement (based in Palestine) and UK-based Afghan Connection were the other two organisations that were nominated by the Forum.

The benchmark for selection was scalability and replicability

of the operating project and its sustained impact on the beneficiaries over a period. Uniqueness, optimised cost and efficiency in mode of project

implementation were the other key criteria for selection.

SCF received the recognition for its 'Build India Through Sports (BITS) Project', which

reaches out to over 35,000 underprivileged children and youth all over India in over 100 low-income institutions such as government schools, municipal schools, orphanages, homes for street children, etc. It strives to promote sports culture with a view to empowering the underprivileged and spreading the message that 'education without sports is incomplete' and that 'sports is the cheapest medicine for good health.'

The awards ceremony was inaugurated by HSH Prince Albert II of Monaco and Al Khalifa of Bahrain (Heir to King of Bahrain and President of Bahrain Olympic Committee) and was attended by top dignitaries including special advisor to UN (Sports for Development & Peace) Wilfried Lemke, Nobel Peace laureates, legendary Olympians among others.

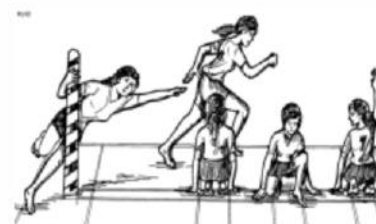

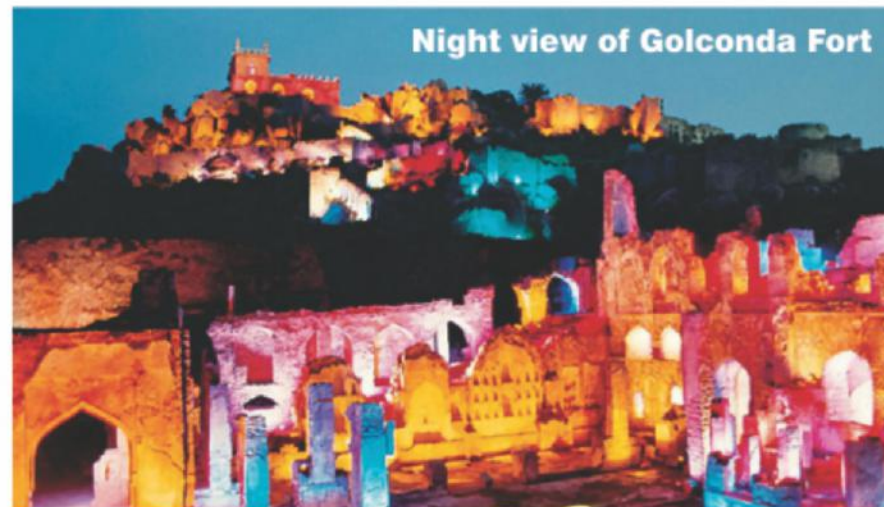

- Did you know that this area called “MASAB TANK” derived its name from “Maa-Saheba” ?
- “Maa-Saheba” was a special name coined for Hayath Bakshi Begum - A Queen Mother of Qutb Shahi Dynasty who ruled Golconda for 175 years (1512-1687)-Founders of Hyderabad City.
- ”Maa-Saheba” (Hayath Bakshi Begum) was a famous Queen Mother and a Social Change Icon who symbolized Social Reformation for empowering the poor of the society. People almost worshipped her.
- MASAB TANK was a special name coined for a Tank (Now Dry) in the name of Hayath Bakshi Begum (“Maa-Saheba”).
- Hayathnagar - a suburban town in Ranga Reddy District of Telangana was also named in 1624 in reverence of Hayath Bakshi Begum.

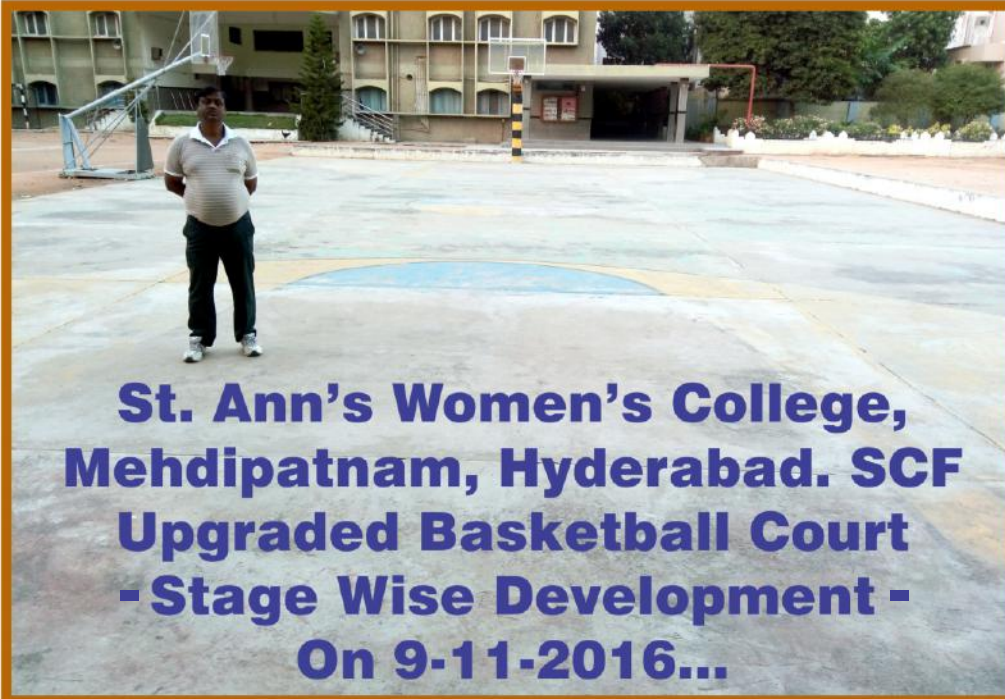

# Govt shortlists 10 key areas of CSR

**New Delhi:** The government has identified 10 major areas including education, gender equality, environment, national heritage and the Prime Minister Relief fund where India Inc can spend to claim credit for the mandatory 2% Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) expenditure.

Under the new Companies Act, mid and large companies have to spend 2% of their three year annual average net profit on CSR activities. The government expects a significant step up in spending on CSR projects by companies.

The activities which can be included by companies in their CSR policies include: eradicating hunger, poverty, malnutrition and promoting preventive healthcare, promoting sanitation and availability of safe drinking water, promoting education, promoting gender equality, ensuring environmental sustainability, protection of national heritage.

Those spending for the benefit of armed forces veterans, war widows and their dependents would be eligible to cover the expenses under CSR spending rules. Under gender equality activities related to empowering women, setting

up homes and hostels for women and orphans, setting up old age homes, day care centres and similar facilities for senior citizens

and projects on reducing inequalities faced by socially and economically backward groups have been included.

**Spending on training to promote rural and nationally recognised Para Olympic and Olympic sports would also qualify for credit under the CSR rules.**

ral development projects and contributions or funds to technology incubators located within academic institutions and approved by the government would also be approved under this category. Protection of national heritage would include art and culture including restoration of building and sites of historical importance and works of art, setting up of public libraries, promotion and development of traditional arts and handicrafts.

Officials said they expect the rules to be notified soon, maybe within a few days, after the Law ministry approves the list. The rules were finalised after the Corporate Affairs ministry examined over one lakh suggestions from various stakeholders. While the rules do not elaborate on the sub categories under rural development projects, officials said they expect several projects to be covered under the category for CSR spending.
